Report from the Regular Meeting of October 19, 2006.

- (1) **Mr. Weber** – gave an overview of the financial report through September 2006; reviewed with the Board information concerning the approval of a purchase order exceeding 10% of original obligation; gave the Board an overview of the appropriation modifications for FY 2007; reviewed the 5 year forecast; and reported that the GAAP audit has been completed paving the way for the State examiners to come in sometime in the near future to complete the audit.
 - (2) **Mr. Lewis/Mrs. Rami** – **Mr. Lewis** reviewed our building Safety Plans; reported on a meeting with Mr. Nairus, our Area Coordinator, concerning funding issues to make certain we are receiving all the funding to which we are entitled; and reported that we have nine (9) teachers who will be out at some point this year on some type of leave. **Mrs. Rami** gave a curriculum overview including the monitoring of monthly assessments and gave a report on our on-going professional development with Dr. Forget.
