The School

Olmsted Falls High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school which operates with the following mission:

The professional staff of Olmsted Falls High School believes that student achievement is based upon shared responsibility of staff, students, parents, and community. It is the mission of Olmsted Falls High School to

- 1. encourage students to recognize that seeking knowledge and learning is an important personal responsibility that is an integral part of the life process
- inspire students to become self-directed, productive, and compassionate members of a culturally and ethnically diverse society
- 3. maintain and further promote high academic standards for students
- equip students to compete in a highly technological world which requires collection, management, analysis, and interpretation of information
- 5. provide a safe and supportive environment in which students can accomplish these goals

Olmsted Falls High School stresses academic excellence as well as physical and social development. Recognized as one of the top 75 high schools in the state, the curriculum offers over 127 courses in fine arts, business, family and consumer sciences, and all academic areas, including courses in advanced placement math, science, language arts, and social studies. Olmsted Falls has been mentioned in Cleveland Magazine and the Cleveland Plain Dealer as one of the top schools in Northeast Ohio. In 1998 our school was recognized as a "Blue Ribbon" National School of Excellence by the Department of Education in Washington, D. C.

The present high school building was opened in the fall of 1968 and houses a 2008-2009 enrollment of 1178 students in grades 9 through 12. A 4.6 million dollar renovation was completed in 1997.

In addition to the high school curriculum, Olmsted Falls High School is served by Polaris Career Center. At Polaris, 11th and 12th grade students can choose from 28 vocational courses ranging from Cosmetology to Welding. More information can be obtained by visiting Polaris' website at www.polaris.edu.

An array of activities are available to our students. The school's athletic and academic teams participate in the Southwestern Conference, which includes Berea, Brecksville, Midpark, Amherst, North Olmsted, Avon Lake, and Westlake. In addition to athletics, we also offer opportunities in music, various clubs, drama and forensics. Olmsted Falls High School continues to focus on offering a strong, balanced curriculum and co-curricular program.
