The School

Olmsted Falls High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school which operates with the following mission:

The professional staff of Olmsted Falls High School believes that student achievement is based upon shared responsibility of staff, students, parents, and community. It is the mission of Olmsted Falls High School to ensure the following:

- 1. Encourage students to recognize that seeking knowledge and learning is an important personal responsibility that is an integral part of the life process.
- Inspire students to become self-directed, productive, and compassionate members of a culturally and ethnically diverse society.
- Maintain and further promote high academic standards for students.
- Equip students to compete in a highly technological world which requires collection, management, analysis, and interpretation of information.
- 5. Provide a safe and supportive environment in which students can accomplish these goals.

Olmsted Falls High School stresses academic excellence as well as physical and social development, and is recognized as one of the highest achieving high schools in Northeast Ohio. The curriculum offers over 93 courses in fine arts, technology, and all academic areas, including courses in advanced placement math, science, language arts, and social studies. Olmsted Falls has been mentioned in Cleveland Magazine and the Cleveland Plain Dealer as one of the top schools in Northeast Ohio. In 2011, Olmsted Falls High School was named as one of the top 500 high schools in the nation by Newsweek Magazine.

The present high school building was opened in the fall of 1968 and a 4.6 million dollar renovation was completed in 1997. The high school houses an enrollment of 1199 students in grades 9 through 12.

In addition to the high school curriculum, Olmsted Falls High School is served by Polaris Career Center. At Polaris, 11th and 12th grade students can choose from 23 vocational courses ranging from aeronautics to welding. An array of activities are available to our students. The school's athletic and academic teams participate in the Southwestern Conference, which includes Amherst, Avon Lake, Berea-Midpark, Brecksville, North Olmsted and Westlake. In addition to athletics and academics, we also offer opportunities in music, drama, forensics and various clubs. Olmsted Falls High School continues to focus on offering a strong, balanced curriculum and cocurricular program.
