

Olmsted Falls Middle School Music Concert Policy

All concerts are a **required** part of the curriculum of all performing ensembles in the Olmsted Falls School District. All parents or guardians must sign and return the parent acknowledgement form included in this packet stating they have read and understand the music performance policies.

CONCERT POLICIES:

- Arrival/Departure:
 - o Be on time--Being tardy will lower your concert grade by one letter.
 - o Stay until the end--Leaving early will lower your concert grade by one letter.
- Uniform Information:
 - Read the uniform information page and make sure that you have all necessary parts of the uniform.
 - If you need financial assistance with your uniform, fill out the Financial Assistance form and return it to the school.
 - Failure to dress appropriately may result in a lowered grade and/or exclusion from participation.
- Behavior Issues:
 - o During warm-ups--Reduction in concert grade by one letter grade
 - o During other performances--Reduction in concert grade by one letter grade
 - o While onstage (at director's discretion)
 - Reduction in concert grade by at least one letter grade
 - Zero credit for concert grade
 - Removal from stage

^{**}If a student is suspended from school they receive 1 day per school day that they are suspended to contact the teacher to schedule time to make up the work.

CONCERT ATTENDANCE POLICY:

- Students are required to participate in all ensemble performances.
 - o Examples of EXCUSED ABSENCES:
 - Emergency beyond the control of student or parent
 - Illness
 - Other reasons with 30 day approval (see below)
 - All EXCUSED ABSENCES must be scheduled for make up within 5 days of the concert with the following assignments as part of the concert grade:
 - Concert Video Analysis (25 points)
 - Music Concept Quiz (50 points)
 - ONE of the three alternative assignments: (125 points)
 - 1. Sing/play one of your songs for the class.
 - 2. Sing/play all of your songs privately with teacher.
 - 3. Write a 2- page, typed paper as assigned by the teacher.
 - o Examples of UNEXCUSED ABSENCES:
 - Lack of transportation
 - Non-school sponsored sporting event
 - Other reasons not approved 30 days in advance (see below)
 - o An UNEXCUSED ABSENCE from a performance will result in a <u>failing</u> grade for the marking period in which the absence occurs. Other performances may be added and required if more than one month's notice is given to the student.
 - o 30 Day Approval
 - Under exceptional circumstances, an UNEXCUSED ABSENCE may be EXCUSED when arrangements are made at least 30 days in advance of the performance and approved by the director. (Example: planned family vacation).
 - All excuses must be made in writing to the director by the student's parent(s).
 - Adherence to this policy will insure that all students will receive the best possible experience.



Therefore, it is very important that you note these two dates on your home calendar at this time. Notification regarding your child's participation will be given 4 weeks in advance of May 5, 2017.

Classroom behavior expectations:

- Be in your assigned seat, quiet, with your folder and sharpened pencil, ready to begin rehearsal BEFORE the tardy bell rings.
- Talking is not allowed in class. During rehearsal, if your section is not rehearsing, you are expected to be following along and silently studying your part.
- Raise your hand to be addressed by teacher. Be courteous to others and listen while they are speaking and or singing/playing.
- Be kind and respectful to peers, teachers, and guests.
- Eating, drinking, and gum chewing are not allowed in the music rooms.
- Take care of the room and all equipment and materials. The piano, phone, stereo and sound equipment are off limits to students. The practice rooms, ensemble rooms, and director's office are off limits without permission from the director.
- Remain in your assigned seat throughout class. All personal needs should be taken care of before the bell rings. This includes restroom, Kleenex, materials, and water. Remain in your seat until the choir director (not the bell) dismisses class.
