**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR ISSUE 107, THE
PROPOSED LEVY FOR THE OLMSTED FALLS CITY SCHOOL
DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Issue 107 is Olmsted Falls City School District's only local operating support; and

WHEREAS, the Olmsted Falls School District is intertwined in the social and business fabric of our community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Olmsted Falls believes that a strong school district is essential to a strong community; and

WHEREAS, the Olmsted Falls City Schools have continued to demonstrate a record of success and excellence in academics, athletics and extracurricular activities for the past decade; and

WHEREAS, the Schools provide essential support for community recreation for our youth and citizenry; and

WHEREAS, the school district has kept its operations efficient and costs among the lowest in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Olmsted Falls City Council supports the principles of Education; and

WHEREAS, failure to pass Issue 107 will cause erosion of our community's educational system that will harm the value and stability of our overall community.



**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS,
CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

SECTION 1. This Council expresses its absolute and unconditional support for Issue 107, the Olmsted Falls City School District Levy.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
