★ Monthly Classroom Guidance Lessons

- -Topics include managing emotions (Zones of Regulation), Conflict Resolution (Kelso's Choices), Big Problems Vs. Small Problems, Growth Mindset, Cooperation, and Flexibility.

- -With parent and teacher input, small groups are formed throughout the year.
- -These groups are 8 week sessions that last approximately 20 minutes per week. Depending on the need, some examples of groups that may be offered are self regulation, worry/anxiety, or changing families.

★ Individual Counseling

-Teachers, parents, or administrators can refer students for individual counseling sessions/check-ins for various reasons. Parents can call, email, (ahays@ofcs.net) or talk to their classroom teacher.















School Counseling Program

★ Mindful Mornings

-For students who are having difficulty with separation anxiety. Morning meetings to learn calming and coping strategies before going to class.

★ Backpack Club

-If you qualify for free and reduced lunch, you are eligible to participate in the "Backpack Club." This is a program that provides supplemental food bags to students for the weekend. It is a confidential program in which bags are placed discreetly into the backpacks of students.

★ Kinder Council

-A program in which teachers pick a student from each class to help represent our student body. These students meet with the principal and counselor bimonthly to support service projects and to discuss likes/dislikes, ideas, and ways to improve our overall climate of the school.

★ Collaboration

-With Mrs. Doick (District Behavioral Specialist) and Melissa Marano (Home Liaison) to support students both at home and in-person.
