Reports from the Regular Meeting/Work Session of April 16, 2009, Regular Meeting of April 23, 2009, and Special Meeting of April 28, 2009.

April 16, 2009 – Work Session

- C. Administrative Reports
 - (1) **Mr. Hullman** provided the financial report for the period ending March 31, 2009; he discussed the 5-year forecast analysis as well as gave an analysis of the new intermediate school project; reviewed the appropriation amendment for FY '09; and reviewed the rationale for his recommendation of an agreement with Lorain National Bank.
 - (2) **Mr. Lewis** reported on the personnel vacancies to be interviewed and posted; reported that the District will be conducting a health insurance *dependent* audit next month to help identify *eligible dependents* on our health insurance; and discussed how a technology plan will be developed for our e-rate funding as is required every 3 years. (The challenge we face is to incorporate this plan with our CIP.)

- (3) **Dr. Lloyd** provided an update regarding the implementation and monitoring of the District's Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP); recognition and thanks were given to the building administrators and the teachers who have done a great job taking the concepts learned in the District's professional development and applying them within the classroom; while there is still much left to do, the staff should be recognized for the dedication to the level of implementation that has been demonstrated thus far; and a PowerPoint presentation was given and it is posted at the following URL: http://bulldogcia.com/Documents/CIP/April BOE Pres OIP.pdf
- (4) Mr. Atkinson Transportation: reported that Cook Road, west of Stearns, will close for about 4-6 weeks beginning Monday, April 20; bus driver physicals will be conducted by Southwest Urgicare the week of May 4th; bus inspection dates will be June 10 and July 14 by the State Highway Patrol; approximately 10 drivers are participating in the School Bus Roadeo at Midview High School on May 2, 2009; and Irene Stoyka was selected by our staff as this year's "Driver of the Year." (As a result, she is a candidate for the "North Region Driver of the Year.") Buildings and Grounds: Heath Krakowiak completed the update necessary for our District's MSDS books in all buildings; after attending a construction recovery meeting, it was determined that we are on schedule for our new intermediate school; Edwards Tree Service is clearing the area at the Middle School which will allow us to begin preparation for grass seeding and future development of athletic areas; bids for furniture and playground equipment were opened April 22; software package called "School Dude" is being investigated which will help with the scheduling of building usage; the County plans to do a locally funded resurfacing project in 2010 for Usher Road between Sprague and Bagley; the County will be installing a permanent traffic light at Usher and Schady roads; and we will begin sharing ideas with our head custodians regarding the 2009-2010 building custodial staff assignments with an afternoon work session; Personnel: head custodian meeting was held to discuss topics related to HB 264, summer projects, and summer staff; and a bus driver meeting is scheduled to discuss routing plans for the 2009-2010 school year.
- (5) **Dr. Hoadley** reported that the Board will require a "special" meeting to approve the furniture bids and soft-surface playground equipment for the new intermediate school and this will occur on April 28, 2009 at the Polaris Career Center where the Board will be attending a Polaris event; that the next Work Session of the Board (May 7, 2009) will begin with a tour of the construction site of the new intermediate school (*requiring hard hats*), and then move the meeting to the offices of the Board of Education; that the next Regular Meeting of the Board will be on May 21 at the High School Media Center where we will be honoring Middle School students who achieved a high academic score on the Midwest Talent Search exam and high achieving students who took the National Latin exam; and then shared the National Honor Society ceremony program with the Board.
