Report from the Regular Meeting of February 18, 2010

# 2. **Administrative Reports**

- A. Mr. Hullman reviewed the financial statements for the period ending January 31, 2010; submitted request for approval of the October 2009 5-Year Forecast Amendment #1; requested approval as the Olmsted Falls Board of Education designee for pubic records training.
- B. Mr. Lewis reported on the challenges of creating a meaningful professional development day for the variety of job classifications in our District, however, believes it was beneficial to all; still working on Unfair Labor Practices filing through SERB and agreed that administration and OFEA will meet with a mediator concerning communication issues; gave an update on the OAPSE grievance concerning our bus driver layoff; and reported that a meeting is being scheduled with our key levy parents to discuss inequities in Ohio school funding.
- C. <u>Dr. Lloyd</u> Dr. Lloyd again discussed the Credit Flexibility requirements that are contained under Ohio Senate Bill 311. The District has been studying the requirements under this piece of legislation since August, 2009. Staff members have attended webinars and conferences in order to increase their understanding of this important piece of legislation. Dr. Lloyd reviewed the local board requirements under SB311 and indicated that the High School's Instructional Leadership Team has been tasked with creating a set of procedures and guidelines that will be recommended to the Board of Education in June or July.
- D. Mr. Atkinson Transportation reported that: the County has tentatively scheduled resurfacing project for the entire length of Usher Road (between Sprague and Bagley) from July thru October; we are working to develop a school bus maintenance contract with the Fairview Park City Schools; K-8 reinstatement of busing is scheduled for February 22, 2010; the State Highway Patrol inspected five (5) buses on January 27; Inservice Day provided opportunities for our mechanical staff to hear topics on catalytic converter regeneration operation; thermo-pane glass theory, vehicle battery operation and diagnosis, proper use of fire extinguishers and Merritt Waters addressed topics related to IEP processes and other special education issues to our drivers; Buildings and Grounds Township approved an additional storage shed for the practice football field behind the High School which is an Eagle Scout project being financed and completed by student Ben Coyle; currently studying our Xerox copier status and our auxiliary printer status in order to better understand where we may be able to reduce our printing costs and increase efficiency; loose furnishings and technology bids are scheduled to be opened on March 18; Personnel Judy Harrigan, Middle School cleaner announced her retirement effective March 1 and Sandy Houser, bus driver, resigned prior to layoff reinstatement.
- E. <u>Dr. Hoadley</u> reviewed again "The Path We Choose" (our Educational Reduction Plan) as a result of our issue passing on February 2 and the options now available; reviewed the HS Program of Studies, specifically new classes AP Statistics which uses the current statistics textbook; and Pathway to Engineering which is being introduced and is being paid for by the Polaris Career Center; and gave the Board a handout from the book *Good to Great*.
