- 4. **Administrative Reports**
 - A. Mr. Hullman reviewed the financial statements for the period ending February 28, 2010; requested approval for an appropriation amendment for FY 2010; and requested approval for new depository agreements with First Place Bank and The Farmers Savings Bank.
 - B. Mr. Lewis reported on personnel needs for the 2010-2011 school year; gave updates on various union grievances/mediations; and reviewed the Genetic Information NonDiscrimination Act (GINA) that went into effect on November 21, 2009 which prohibits employers from discriminating against applicants and employees based on genetic information.
 - C. <u>Dr. Lloyd</u> <u>Curriculum</u> reviewed the information concerning revising academic content standards with an emphasis on 3 things: focus, coherence and rigor; reported that the OGT will be replaced with (1) a 3-part system that will include a nationally standardized assessment in science, language arts and math, (2) a series of end-of-course exams in the 4-core, and (3) and a senior project; <u>Instruction</u> reported that we continue to monitor our Continuous Improvement Plan; and reported that during the past few years, over 12,000 classroom walk-throughs have been made; <u>Assessment</u> reported that we have focused this school year on student assessment; partnered with the Greater Cleveland Educational Development Center (GCEDC) getting many of our teachers developed in the art of formative assessment; <u>Miscellaneous Items</u> Dr. Lloyd, Mark Kurz, the 8th grade social studies teachers, and Lisa Williams will present at the 2nd Annual Action Forum for the Ohio Leadership Advisory Council in June, 2010 on the role and function of Teacher Based Teams; and reported that we have created a Relay for Life team *Bulldog Board Walkers* which will compete against other teams on June 12, 2010.
 - D. Mr. Atkinson Transportation reported that the State Highway Patrol inspection is scheduled for June 16 and August 17, 2010; requested the Board to approve a school bus maintenance contract with the Fairview Park Schools; continuing to explore High School busing options for the 2010-11 school year; Buildings and Grounds addressing some structural/masonry issues at the Bus Garage; selected site of the field directly south of the Middle School main parking lot to host the Kiwanis sponsored circus tent this summer; addressing issues in the High School stadium football pressbox ceiling; reported that the High School stadium visitor bleacher pressbox will be taken down this summer due to lack of use and the number of repairs

- necessary to maintain it in a safe condition; our District water backflow devices will be inspected over spring break; head custodians are compiling a list of proposed and planned summer projects for our buildings; **Personnel**: have begun the staff appraisal process; and reported that summer staff applications are due by April 1.
- E. <u>Dr. Hoadley</u> reviewed the new curriculum at the HS (i.e., pre-engineering; bio-medical science I; bio-medical sciences II; and nutrition and wellness I and II); gave a review of the meeting with the Ohio School Facilities Commission on March 17 and the request for them to continue reviewing our Master Plan for future construction; reported on a meeting with the insurance committee and that Mr. Caito (our insurance consultant) was in attendance; reported that we are exploring an alternative to our Ombudsman program at the High School to see if we can incur a savings and increase opportunities for our students; reviewed personnel plans for the 2010-11 school year with the possibility of 6-8 new faces thereby keeping our campaign promise to reduce class sizes; and reviewed possible transportation changes for the 2010-11 school year.
